

**USS MARIAS AO-57, USS CADMUS AR-14, USS AMPHION AR-13, & USS ARCADIA AD-23
2010 Reunion Information**

The USS MARIAS, USS CADMUS, USS AMPHION, & USS ARCADIA reunion will be held April 29-02 May, 2010 at the Philadelphia Airport Marriott located at 1 Arrivals Rd, Philadelphia, PA 19153. The hotel is connected to the airport Terminal B US Airways via skywalk. Please note the Information kiosk at the bottom of the escalator used to access baggage claim. If you don't want to walk to the hotel please pick up the red phone and dial #45 to request a complimentary Hotel Shuttle pick up. Be sure to stand in Zone #4 on the arrivals side of baggage claim for the shuttle. If Arriving in Terminal F, please note that after picking up your luggage please call for a complimentary shuttle pick up by dialing any white phone on the wall extension 2900 then wait directly outside in front of the baggage claim for the hotel van. Parking at the hotel has been reduced to \$10.00 a day. The Marriott is a first class hotel with all of the amenities needed for a successful reunion. The management and staff are anxious to show you their hotel! **Questions:** The information contained herein should answer most of your questions; however, if anything is unclear, please do not hesitate to call our Customer Service Representative at **1-828-256-6008**.

A word about cost. This reunion is a bit more expensive than in the past, we know that. The room rate in this super Marriott is the same rate as the Sheraton in Charleston last year. The Philadelphia tax rate is higher, making the overall room cost \$3.00 more than Charleston. So rooms are not the cause of the increase; nor are it the fee we charge – that has not changed since 2006 in spite of the increased expenses we have incurred. We feel like we are doing everything possible to make the cost affordable to everyone. The increase is simply because food and taxes are higher in Philadelphia than Charleston, Mobile and elsewhere. We (ML & RS Inc) cannot negotiate taxes. Remember, you select the site, we provide you with the best possible prices for the location that you choose.

The registration packets are being sent early to give you more time. The Saturday night banquet menu is being changed from “all beef” prime rib or filet mignon to fish or chicken. Be sure to make your selection on the registration form. If you need to make “installments” that is fine, so long as the final payment is made by the cut-off date. We want you there for what is going to be one of the really great reunions and there is a wonderful program set up for you. The history of Philadelphia, the program, and most importantly, seeing old shipmates is a great incentive. We know you'll want to be there!

YOUR ITINERARY

Thursday April 29, 2010

12:00 Noon: Registration Begins and the Hospitality Room opens stocked with coffee, soft drinks, and snacks. Because of liability considerations, private alcoholic beverages cannot be brought into the hospitality room. The hospitality room will close during the welcome reception.

5:00—6:00 PM: Welcome reception begins. After a few welcome remarks mini Philly Cheese Steaks and mini Philly Hoagies will be served and the cash bar will open. Enjoy the evening in a relaxed and cheerful atmosphere. *Cost of the reception is included in the price of Option A only. If you cannot participate in the reception, you may opt-out; see Registration Form, Adjustment Opportunities, “Deduct Thursday’s Reception.”*

Friday April 30, 2010

7:30-8:30 AM: Breakfast will be a private buffet. A variety of different breakfast item selections will be available. Eat at your leisure during this hour, keeping in mind when the tour departs.. *Cost of breakfast is included in Option A only. If you cannot participate in breakfast, you may opt-out; see Registration Form, Adjustment Opportunities, “Deduct Breakfast” (be sure to indicate which morning).*

9:00 AM: Hospitality Room opens and Registration resumes.

8:45 AM: Load ‘em up’ 9:00 AM move ‘em out: Optional Historic and Cultural tour of Philadelphia departs. Today you will see where history was made as you walk in the footsteps of our founding fathers in “Greene Countrie Towne”, Philadelphia. In an area known as “America’s Most Historic Mile” you will visit or pass sites such as Independence Hall where the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution were signed; Congress Hall, The Liberty Bell (America’s most cherished artifact) Elfreth’s Alley (the oldest continuously occupied street in the USA), Betsy Ross House, and Christ Church established in 1695 where many of the founding fathers worshiped. There will be a narrated driving tour of downtown Philadelphia including the Penn’s Landing area along the Delaware waterfront, and the Society Hill neighborhood, and the Benjamin Franklin Parkway, and City Hall. One of the highlights will be a visit to the National Constitution Center. This facility is dedicated to help people better understand the Constitution and its impact on our lives. This will be a truly entertaining and educational day. There is some walking involved, wear comfortable walking shoes and clothes. There will be time to eat lunch on your own, rest a bit and enjoy the riding portion of the tour. You’ll return to the hotel around 4:00 PM. There is a 30 person per bus minimum. Some admission tickets must be purchased in advance, so registering for the tour on site may not be possible, please register in advance. *Cost of this tour is not included in either of the options. 6:00 PM: Social hour begins. Enjoy your favorite beverage from the cash bar while you anticipate a good meal and a fun evening.

7:00 PM: Dinner is served. Tonight’s dinner will be a “home-style” buffet featuring salad, Cole slaw, fried chicken, meat loaf, vegetables, dessert, coffee & tea. After dinner we’ll have some sort of self-entertainment, maybe a repeat of the “Name That Song (with different songs); maybe our very own talent contest; can you sing or dance (or do you think you can), do magic tricks, tell jokes, If you have a talent, share it with us! *Cost of dinner is included in Options A and B. 8:45 AM: Load ‘em up; 9:00 AM: Move ‘em out for the Camden Waterfront – home of Campbell’s soups, Victor Victrola Records and the Battleship New Jersey. This “Big J”, as she was nicknamed, was built entirely at the Philadelphia Navy Yard and launched in December 1942. During her 48 years of service, she became the most decorated ship in US Naval history, receiving 19 battle stars. She was the Flagship for Admiral Halsey. She served in WW II, Korea, and Viet Nam. Please remember you will be walking in cramped spaces and climbing ladders, so wear comfortable walking shoes – pants are recommended for the ladies. If you do not feel comfortable with a complete tour, you can enjoy a main deck tour, which does not have any ladders. A video tour of the Battleship is offered in the Wardroom Lounge on the Main Deck. Chances are no one will bring a baby so we’ll skip the part about baby strollers. A box lunch is included in the tour price. You will truly enjoy the day. There is a 30 person per bus minimum. You’ll arrive back at the hotel around 1:00 PM. *Cost of this tour is not included in either of the options. You must register for the tour separately. See the Registration Form, Adjustment Opportunities Block “Add Saturday’s Tour”.*

10:00 AM: Hospitality room opens if anyone does not go on the tour. It will be stocked with fresh coffee and cold drinks. Snacks will be served in the afternoon. Registration will resume for Saturday arrivals.

6:30 PM: Pre-dinner Cocktail hour and photo session begins. Individual and/or couples photos will be taken for inclusion in the 2010 Reunion Memory Book.
