

Combat Infantrymen's Association 2010 Reunion Information

The Combat Infantrymen's Association annual Convention will be held October 21-24, 2010 at the Holiday Inn SeaTac, located at 17338 International Blvd, Seattle, WA. The Holiday Inn is a first class hotel with all of the amenities that you have come to expect, in your room and in the rest of the facility as well. You'll find complimentary high speed internet access, personal care items, iron & ironing board, full service restaurant and lounge, plus much more. There is complimentary airport shuttle service to/from SeaTac International Airport. To obtain transportation from SeaTac use the courtesy phone located near the baggage claim area or call the hotel direct at 1-206-248-1000. Parking for the CIA has been reduced from the standard \$12.00 a day parking to only \$5.00 a day. Directions to the hotel will be included with your confirmation letter. Option A

YOUR ITINERARY

Thursday October 21, 2010

12:00 Noon: Registration Begins and the Hospitality Room opens stocked with coffee, soft drinks, and snacks. Because of liability considerations, private alcoholic beverages cannot be brought into the hospitality room. HQ 1 1 WA will staff and stock the hospitality room. **Note to HQ 1 1 WA - By contractual agreement, the hospitality room must close during the welcome reception and all hotel sponsored functions.**

5:00—6:00 PM: Welcome reception begins. This is the first planned function of the convention. Enjoy your favorite beverage from the cash bar and some appetizing hors d'oeuvres to prepare you for dinner on your own. National Commander Earl Kennedy will make a few welcome remarks prior to the food and bar service. *Cost of the reception is included in the price of Option A only. If you can not participate in the reception, you may opt-out. See the Registration Form, Adjustment Opportunities Block "Deduct Thursday's Reception".*

Friday October 22, 2010

Breakfast will be in the hotel restaurant. Coupons will be provided; eat at your leisure, keeping in mind when the Ft Lewis tour departs. *Cost of breakfast is included in Option A. If you cannot participate in breakfast, you may opt-out; see the Registration Form, Adjustment Opportunities Block, delete breakfast (be sure to specify which morning.)*

8:15 AM: Load 'em up' 8:30 AM move 'em out: Optional trip to Ft Lewis. **Highlights of your trip will consist of a very special visit to Joint Base Lewis-Mchord, the home of I Corps—America's Corps— and three of the Army's finest Stryker Brigades. You will have the pleasure of viewing several monuments honoring the 3rd Infantry Division, WW II; 4th Infantry division, and the famous Lewis-Clark expedition. Many of you recall living in wooden barracks in years past. We will tour/visit a brand new set of barracks that our soldiers of today live in. We will also visit the housing area where our married soldiers live. We will visit the 1st battalion, 23rd Infantry (this is one of the battalions of the regiment that broke the Chinese from over-running Korea). Our lunch, (on your own) will be at the Cascade Community Club. Directly following lunch we will visit the 1st Special Forces Group where you will be given the opportunity to meet and speak with several of today's infantry soldiers. Cost of this tour is not included in either of the options. You must register for the tour separately. See the Registration Form, Adjustment Opportunities Block, Add Friday's tour.**

9:00 AM: Hospitality Room opens if anyone does not go on the tour. HQ 1 1 WA will staff and stock the hospitality room.

1000 AM: Registration will resume for Friday arrivals.

You can have lunch, (on your own here) followed by a visit to the Space Needle (admission included); and time permitting, a short riding tour of Seattle. Relax from the business end of the convention and enjoy a little of Seattle. *Since this is an OPTIONAL tour the cost is not included in either of the Option Prices; you must register separately. 6:30 PM: Pre-dinner Cocktail hour
