The 2010 NEWPORT DEALEYS reunion will be held **Sept 30-03 Oct** at Marriott Hotel Mobile, located at 3101 Airport Blvd, Mobile, AL. The location in the heart of Mobile's shopping and entertainment district is ideal with restaurants, shopping, and night life nearby with quick access to major highways. The Marriott is a first class hotel with all of the amenities needed for a super reunion. All 251 hotel rooms feature Marriott's new revive bedding package. Standard amenities include AM/FM alarm clock radio, personal care items, in-room coffee service, iron & ironing board, hair dryer, a work station, and internet access. Parking is complimentary and ample. Mobile home and RV parking is available to registered guests who occupy a hotel room. You may not live in a camper or RV on hotel property. Complimentary airport shuttle is not provided. Yellow Cab is one of the commercial transportation services available. Call 251-475-7711 to secure a ride. It is approximately seven miles from the airport to the hotel. YOUR ITINERARY

Thursday September 30, 2010

12:00 Noon: Registration Begins and the Hospitality Room opens stocked with coffee, soft drinks, and snacks. Because of liability considerations, private alcoholic beverages cannot be brought into the hospitality room. What you do in your own room is your business. The hospitality room will close during the welcome reception.

5:00—6:00 PM: Welcome reception begins. This is the first “planned” function. Enjoy your favorite beverage from the cash bar and after a few welcome and admin announcements, light hors d’oeuvres will be served. Dinner is on your own tonight. *Cost of the reception is included in the price of Option A only. If you cannot participate in the reception, you may opt-out. Friday October 1, 2010

7:30 – 8:30 AM: Breakfast will be a private buffet. Eat at your leisure during this hour, keeping in mind the tour departs at 9:00. *Cost of breakfast is included in Option A. If you cannot participate in breakfast, you may opt-out, see the Registration Form, Adjustment Opportunities Block “Deduct Breakfast” (be sure to indicate which morning).*

9:00 AM: Optional Battleship Alabama/Mobile City tour departs. The Mobile Military Park, one of America’s finest Military Parks has displays from World War II to Iraqi Freedom. Here at Battleship Memorial Park you’ll walk the decks of a mighty battleship. Go below in a World War II submarine. View cockpits of combat aircraft. You’ll also see tanks, a Vietnam River Patrol Boat, and a plane like the one flown by the Tuskegee Airmen. It’s all here, all waiting to be discovered by you! Once onboard, the group can enter gun turrets, view crew’s quarters, sick bay, an engine room and much more. There are 12 decks open for touring. The main deck of the Battleship is handicapped accessible. You may also enjoy watching a 15 minute film in the Uptake Theater featuring former WWII USS ALABAMA crewmen. After touring the ALABAMA, head down to the 36,000 sq. ft. Aircraft Pavilion, dedicated to the 29 Medal of Honor recipients from the State of Alabama. In here, the group can view aircraft such as the A-12 “Blackbird” Spy Plane and a P51-D Mustang Red Tail, the type of plane flown by the valiant Tuskegee Airmen. Then inspect other aircraft, a Vietnam PBR boat, and wonderful exhibits. Don’t forget to take a ride on the Flight Simulator. Great for the young and young at heart! Submarine USS DRUM is your next stop, also designated a National Historic Landmark. She can be viewed from every vantage point, inside and out. Be sure to visit the inspiring Vietnam and Korean War Memorials also located in the park. Lunch, (included in the tour price) will be served in the Ward Room. After lunch you’ll take a riding tour of Mobile. During the ride-through you’ll hear about the customs, history and architecture of the area. You will love the magnificent live oaks that form a canopy over the streets. Some of the ante-bellum homes are adorned with beautiful iron lace. You will also have the privilege of visiting the first Catholic Parish on the Gulf coast. It was established at Mobile in 1703, one year after the founding of Mobile. In 1704, Father Henri Roulleaux De la Vente was canonically installed as the first pastor of the Church of Fort Louis de la Louisiane (Mobile). When the City of Mobile was relocated to its present site in 1711, the Parish Church was rebuilt on the West side of Royal street just North of Conti Street, under the patronage of Our Lady of Mobile. It was in 1781, in Mobile’s Spanish period, that the parish received its present title “Church of the Immaculate Conception. *Note that the Cathedral closes at 2:00 PM so it may be necessary to rearrange the schedule in order to make this stop.* Depending upon the time available, it may also be possible to stop at Fort Conde, built by the French in 1723. The fort guarded Mobile and its citizens for almost a hundred years until 1813 when Mobile was occupied by United States troops. The original shape of the fort was in the form of a four-pointed star with guard towers raised at the points. Interestingly, that design was still used as recently as the 1970’s in Viet Nam where many US Army Special Forces “A” camps were of that same design. The reconstructed fort takes you back to Mobile’s early days. Although it is an historic place, stopping there is “iffy” because of the time element, and because it is no longer staffed. Unless there is a change the fort will continue to stand empty and deteriorate. At least for the time being, visitors are still being allowed on the grounds. There is a minimum of 35 persons per bus for the tour to go. You will return to the hotel around 3:00-3:30 PM. *This is an optional tour. The cost is not included in either of the options. You must register for the tour separately. See the Registration Form, Adjustment Opportunities Block, “Add Friday’s Tour.”*

10:00 AM: Hospitality Room opens. It will be stocked with fresh coffee and cold drinks. Snacks will be served in the afternoon. Registration will resume for Friday arrivals.

4:00 PM: Business Meeting.

5:30 PM: Social hour begins. Enjoy your favorite beverage from the cash bar while you anticipate a good Mobile-style meal.

6:30 PM: Dinner is served. Tonight you’ll enjoy the Marriot’s famous Mardi Gras dinner buffet featuring shrimp gumbo, chicken and andouille sausage jambalaya, red beans and rice, corn bread, and for dessert bread pudding with a bourbon glaze, topped off with coffee, decaf and iced tea. After dinner activities will be handled by the Committee. *Cost of dinner is included in Options A and B. If you cannot participate in the dinner, you may opt-out. 8:30 AM: Optional tour departs. Today’s tour will take you to the Northrup-Grumman (formerly Ingalls) shipyard for a riding tour of the

facility. Based on the latest information available, seven US Navy ships are being constructed at the facility. Following the shipyard visit, you'll be off to Bellingrath Gardens known as the Garden Spot of the South. The property on which the gardens are today were purchased in 1917 as a fishing camp by Walter Bellingrath, President of Mobile's Coca Cola Bottling Plant. Mrs. Bellingrath began developing the gardens with architect George Bigelow Rogers in 1927. The home was completed in 1935. Immediately upon arrival there you will eat lunch (included in the tour price) at the Magnolia Restaurant. After lunch you can enjoy the floral beauty of the garden. The flowers change seasonally with cascading chrysanthemums in the fall. You will also have a chance to tour the Bellingrath home which is furnished with antique furniture in period settings, plus an outstanding collection of china and porcelain. You will return to the hotel around 4:30 PM. There is a minimum of 35 persons – per bus – for the tour to go. *This is an optional tour. The cost is not included in either of the options. You must register for the tour separately. See the Registration Form, Adjustment Opportunities Block "Add Saturday's Tour."*

6:00 PM: Pre-dinner Cocktail hour and photo session begins. Individual and/or couples photos will be taken for inclusion in the 2010 Reunion Memory Book.
