## Plano's the Place!

Plano's location, approximately 10 miles from Dallas and 20 miles northeast of downtown Dallas, gives us access to North Texas' Biggest Playground. Accessible via D/FW international Airport or Dallas Love Field, or two major highways, Plano's the Place! Once here, the DART light-rail system can get you from Plano to downtown Dallas and points beyond. You'll run out of time before you run out of things to do here. So much to do, it's hard to list it all ...

**Love History?** America's aviation heritage can be experienced at the **Cavanaugh Flight Museum**. The museum fulfills its mission by restoring, operating, maintaining and displaying historically-significant, vintage aircraft, and by collecting materials related to the history of aviation. It's a must-see! (More details below.)

Step back in time for a visit to a 19th century Plano farmhouse and all its original outbuildings. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the **Heritage Farmstead** features a 12-room turn-of-the-century farm home. See transportation history brought back to life at the **Interurban Museum**. The Interurban is one of the original electric cars that ran from north Texas to central Texas.

**Typically Texas?** Plano's modern and high-tech industry includes the headquarters of some of the country's major employers – EDS, Mary Kay Cosmetics (take a tour of the Museum!), Frito-Lay and more. But, you can step back to "typical Texas" at **Southfork Ranch**, home of the most infamous of Texas ranchers, the Ewings. Made famous by the t.v. series, Dallas, you can tour the facilities and grounds that include the Mansion, eat a bite at Miss Ellie's Deli, and shop for typically Texas merchandise in the Ranch Round Up store.
